


First Stay at Hi Noon Ski Club Ltd



Where is the lodge located?

Banjo Drive – take the second right turn into Thredbo (when driving from Jindabyne). The lodge is the green building on your left just before the intersection (Belas Corner).

What to bring

- All food and drinks including tea, coffee, and condiments. The village does have a well-stocked supermarket if supplies required (830am-530pm 7 days).
- The lodge has a well-appointed kitchen, a toaster, electric jug, three microwaves, and a gas cook top. There is no oven but two barbeques on the deck can be used as ovens. There are plenty of saucepans, fry pans and utensils. Crockery and cutlery is also provided.
- Linen You must bring all your own linen including doonas/blankets, pillows, sheets, and towels.
- Soap and toiletries.

Before you arrive:

 Check the club's current COVID rules prior to your arrival and understand your responsibilities whilst staying in the lodge. Note: all guests must check in individually using the Service NSW COVID check in QR code upon entry and add any dependents in your group.

What to do when you arrive

- You can check-in any time after 5 pm during the Winter period (3 pm Summer).
- Introduce yourself to the lodge caretaker unless he/she beats you to it. This winter we have volunteer member caretakers overseeing the lodge operations.
- The room list in the entry shows what room you're in.
- The car parking board will also show whether or not you've been allocated a car park, and which one is yours.
- The lodge caretaker also has a key to the car park chain.
- If you haven't been allocated a car park there is plenty of car parking in the village overnight parking areas down near the Friday Flat see the map on the next page.
- Members will be forwarded the combination number for the front door. Members are expected to provide the code to their guests before their arrival.

During your stay

- Follow the Club's Covid Policy. This will include assisting with cleaning all surfaces of the common areas in the lodge daily.
- Please clean up kitchen after cooking and unpack dishwashers where required.
 Empty full bins, as necessary.
- Switch on the range hood fan before cooking...and remember to switch it off.
- For parents with children, please read the guidelines page 3 of this document.
- If you have any questions about what is expected during your stay, please see the lodge Caretaker.



Getting around the resort

- The lodge is located in the heart of Thredbo and is walking distance to most locations.
- In winter, the road can become icy, and care should be taken when walking out of the lodge.
- A courtesy shuttle bus service operates during the day from Bela's corner immediately across the road from the lower entrance; Route 1. The bus stops at Friday Flat (carpark), Valley Terminal (interchange) and Bela's corner (lodge) with frequency depending on the season. A night bus also operates. What to do before you leave

- You must check out by 4.30 pm during the Winter period (5 pm Summer).
- Leave the room as you found it.
- Clean your room using the vacuum cleaner in the first cupboard near the bathroom area – look for the outlets for the vacuum cleaner along the corridor – pick the one nearest to your room. Also wipe surface areas including drawers, window sills and mirrors.
- Sanitise all benches and touchpoints in your bedroom with disinfectant and sanitiser provided.
- If you're vacating one of the lodge car parks, block off the car park using the padlock and chain.
- If you aren't sure of the checkout procedure, please see the lodge Caretaker/Leader.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS with children staying in the Lodge.

Hi Noon Ski Club Ltd was established for members and their guests to enjoy the benefits of the alpine environment. However, living in the Hi Noon environment we need to be mindful of our responsibilities. This includes everyone adhering to reasonable standards of behaviour towards others, so all members and their guests enjoy their stay. On regular occasions, children are not adequately supervised, which interferes with other guests' enjoyment. Thus, guidelines have been devised for parents and guardians to please follow. **Thank you for your participation.**

1. Supervision of Children: Overall Lodge areas:		
		Please ensure children do not run in any part of the lodge and must be supervised at all times including the balcony.
		Please NO jumping off the stairs! We do not want anyone hurt during their stay.
		Please ensure shildren do not run in any part of the ladge and must be supervised at
		Please ensure children do not run in any part of the lodge and must be supervised at all times.
		Children should not wander around on carpet areas with food and/or drinks.
		Please remove and manage elsewhere children who are throwing tantrums or crying in common areas, so as not to disturb other guests.
		Please contain children's toys to a small part of the common areas and remove once
		play has finished.
		Children helping themselves to other occupants' food in the common area without asking is to be discouraged.
3. 9	Sup	pervision of Children: Bathroom areas:
1 (Please ensure that children are supervised in bathrooms so that toilets are flushed, taps turned off and floors are dry and clean after use.
4. 3	<u>sup</u>	ervision of Children: Bedroom Areas:
		Please ensure that children do not enter other occupants' rooms without invitation. If children wake, continue to cry, and cannot be settled during the night, please remove from bedroom areas.
5. 9	auS	pervision of Children: Kitchen/Dining area:
		Children must be supervised at all times if they are handling food in the kitchen.
		For safety reasons, children under the height of 120cm are not to enter the kitchen area at any time.
		Please ensure that floor areas under dining tables and chairs are swept after use.
<u>6. N</u>	Nap	ppy Management:
		Nappies not to be changed in common areas such as in lounge areas, dining tables, eating areas. Soiled nappies to be disposed of in outside bins (NOT kitchen or

bathroom bins) immediately after removal.

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
