

Policy 1 - Booking A Single Room During Winter

Each of the eleven Hi Noon lodge bedrooms is equipped to accommodate up to four individuals. However, rooms are typically allocated to two guests, who can then choose their sleeping arrangements. Bookings are made on a **per-bed basis**, in alignment with rental charges from KT. Accordingly, bed-by-bed allocation is the standard practice and in peak periods, it can occur that persons are assigned rooms with other unknown individuals.

Single Occupancy Guidelines

In response to evolving accommodation preferences, up to **two rooms per night** will be allocated for **single occupancy during winter**. Single room allocation will be at the discretion of the Booking Officer, with a preference for **rear-facing rooms**, to preserve front-facing views for shared rooms.

The following conditions apply:

1. **Applicability:** This policy applies only during winter season each year.
2. **Eligibility:** Only members may request single occupancy. Guests are not eligible.
3. **Availability:** Requests will be honoured only if suitable rooms are available.
4. **Timing of Requests:** Requests must be submitted at the time of booking.
5. **Payment:** Single occupancy requires payment for **two beds** at the prevailing rate.
6. **Peak Periods:** During high-demand periods, the Booking Officer may enquire whether the member, having booked a single room, is willing to share with another member. Acceptance is optional and may depend on familiarity.
7. **Fee Adjustment:** If the room is shared following such a request, each person will be charged the standard single-bed rate.
8. **Default Assumption:** If single occupancy is not requested and paid for, members should expect to share the room. Requests for single occupancy without payment will not be considered.
